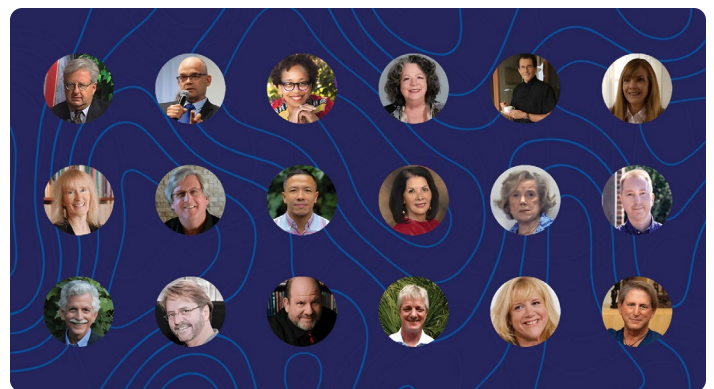
PRESS KIT

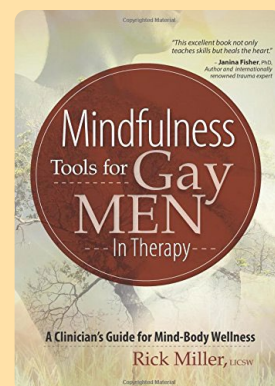
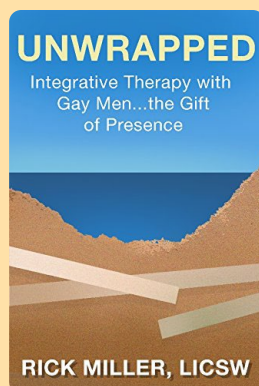
